Daytime opportunities for older people



Hasland Resource Centre is a DCC day service that provides support for people with physical disabilities, people with dementia and people with mental health needs. The service covers the whole of Chesterfield and we also offer a day service within the Staveley Centre.

The Centre is open Monday to Friday and staff are available from 9am to 4pm.

The day centre can accommodate up to 24 people a day in the two lounges. Our team of skilled and trained staff support people with different needs from minimal supervision through to more intensive support.

We work in partnership with other care service providers to deliver personalised support to help clients maintain their independence and remain part of their community. We provide carers with the support they need to have some time to themselves if they need it. We create activities based on personal support plans and monitor and review progress to ensure we meet the persons needs.

What will Hasland Resource Centre provide for you?

We offer a choice of stimulating activities to suit your preferences and abilities:

Refreshments are available on arrival including tea, coffee, hot chocolate, juices and snacks such as toast or biscuits. Refreshments are also served throughout the day.

Lunch is prepared at the centre by our cook who will serve a nutritious two course lunch made from fresh produce. We will make sure we cater for any dietary and health needs you may have.

We have fully adapted toilet facilities and if required our staff can offer support with any personal care needs.

We will create a personal service plan tailored to your individual needs so we know how best to support you when you are at the day centre.

Group Information

We provide specialist dementia groups which are run by workers who have a wealth of experience in caring for individuals living with dementia as well as groups for people with physical disabilities.

Each group has a coordinator responsible for organizing



activities to help stimulate physical and mental skills.

We have 2 lounges at the day centre and we take a maximum of twelve people in each group.

In some of our more specialised groups where people need more support we have less people and have higher ratios of staff.

The day centre operates five days a week and the groups run from 10am to 2pm. If transport is required this will increase the length of the day from 9am to 3.15pm for some people due to the travel time.



Transport

Transport can only be provided to our service if you have had an adult care assessment and are deemed eligible for transport assistance due to your social care needs.

How to Access our Service

Access to our service is dependent on an assessment of your social care needs, in line with national eligibility criteria determined by the Care Act 2014. The Adult Care worker who carries out your assessment will explain the process to you and can also talk about any costs involved.

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
