Community Lives

The Community Lives programme aims to find new ways of supporting people with learning disabilities, their carers and their family members. In 2011 the Community Lives Fieldwork Team and the Community Connector Service was piloted. The fieldwork team carries out assessments and the Community Connector Service works closely with Individuals, over 12 weeks, to develop a support plan. They also link Individuals with local communities and find alternative activities or opportunities for people to participate in.



The Gate House, Long Eaton

The Gate House is a small community base in Long Eaton, In close proximity to Outlook. It is ideal for those who find a smaller environment more suited to their needs.
