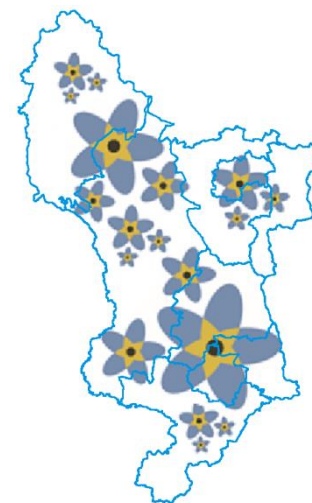
Derbyshire County Council are supporting Safe Places to become more dementia friendly:

- There are currently over 7000 people diagnosed with Dementia in Derbyshire and this figure is set to rise by over 30% by 2030
