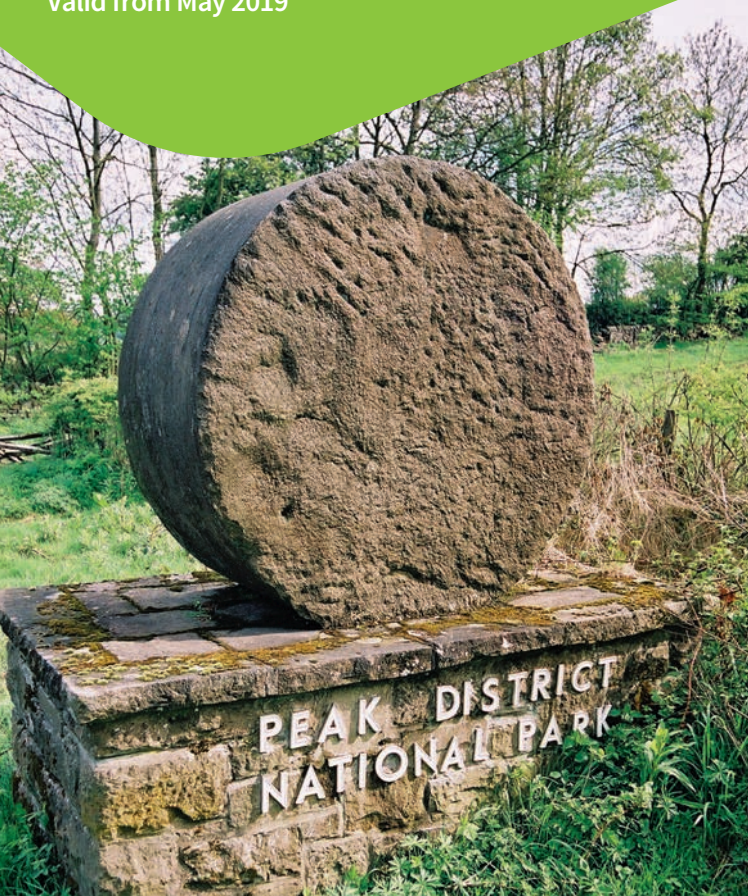

Derbyshire Wayfarer – your all day ticket to ride!

What is a Derbyshire Wayfarer?

One ticket that lets you make as many bus and train trips as you like throughout Derbyshire on a single day.

You make a one-off payment and scratch off the date on the ticket when you want to travel. Then hop aboard the bus at any time or the train after 9.00am.

You can also use your Derbyshire Wayfarer to make trips to and from some places outside the county as long as the journey starts or finishes in Derbyshire, including Burton upon Trent, Leek, Macclesfield, Sheffield and Uttoxeter. Check out the map on page 6 for more information.





How much is a Derbyshire Wayfarer?

They're great value for money – so make the most of your Derbyshire Wayfarer by travelling far and wide!

- £6.70 concessionary for anyone over 60, child*, Gold Card or other English National Concessionary Travel Scheme (ENCTS) cardholder
- £13.40 adult plus one child*
- £24.00 group for two adults and up to three children*

Where can I buy a Derbyshire Wayfarer?

You can get a Derbyshire Wayfarer on the day you want to travel or in advance. To make it valid remember to scratch off the date you want to travel.

On the day of travel:

- **from the driver of these buses:** Arriva Midlands, D&G, High Peak Buses, Hulleys of Baslow, Kinch, Littles, Midland Classic, Notts & Derby, Stagecoach in Chesterfield, Stagecoach in Mansfield, TM Travel, Trent Barton and Yourbus
- **at these railway stations:** Alfreton, Burton upon Trent, Buxton, Chesterfield, Derby, Long Eaton, New Mills Central**, New Mills Newtown** and Sheffield.

* A child is aged between five and 15 inclusive. You will need to prove that you qualify for a concessionary ticket. A dog may travel in place of a child.

**These booking offices are only open until 1.00pm Monday-Friday. Please note that tickets cannot be bought on trains or at unstaffed stations.

- **from bus company travel offices**
at Derby Bus Station
 - **from Tourist Information Centres** in Ashbourne, Bakewell, Buxton, Castleton, Chesterfield, Derby, Edale, Leek and Swadlincote, at New Mills Heritage Centre and at East Staffordshire Borough Council Customer Service Centres in Burton upon Trent and Uttoxeter Town Hall
 - **at libraries** in Alferton, Belper, Dronfield, Glossop, Heanor, Ilkeston, Long Eaton, Matlock, Melbourne and Swadlincote

Using your Derbyshire Wayfarer on buses

You can use your Derbyshire Wayfarer for travel within Derbyshire on all the services operated by the companies listed below, any time and any day of the week. You can also make journeys just over the border between Derbyshire, Burton upon Trent, Leek, Macclesfield, Sheffield city centre and Uttoxeter on bus services run by these operators:

Aimee's, Arriva Midlands, D&G, First, High Peak Buses, Hulleys of Baslow, Kinchbus, Littles, Midland Classic, Notts & Derby*, Stagecoach, TM Travel, Trent Barton and Yourbus.

And on these branded services in Derbyshire:

Allestree, Amberline, Black Cat, Derbyshire Connect, Harlequin, Ilkeston Flyer, Indigo, Mickleover, Nines, Pronto, Rainbow, Royal Derby, Sevens, Sixes, Skylink, Spondon Flyer, Swift, Transpeak, Two and Villager.

Using your Derbyshire Wayfarer on the bus outside the county:

- within Staffordshire on services 441, 442 and Derbyshire Connect
 - within Nottinghamshire on the Ilkeston to Sawley service 15
 - between Derbyshire and East Midlands Airport on service SKY (Skylink Derby/Leicester), SKYN (Skylink Nottingham) and service 15
 - between Glossop and Holmfirth on service 351.

Using your Derbyshire Wayfarer on trains

You can use your Derbyshire Wayfarer on Cross Country Trains, East Midlands Trains, Northern Trains and TransPennine Express, between any of the stations on the following lines. Travel at any time on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays and after 9.00am Monday to Friday.

Buxton - Chapel-en-le-Frith - New Mills (Newtown)

Sheffield - Edale - New Mills Central

Sheffield - Alfreton - Langley Mill - Ilkeston

Sheffield - Chesterfield - Derby

Shirebrook - Whitwell (Robin Hood Line)

Derby - Belper - Matlock

Derby - Long Eaton

Derby - Tutbury and Hatton - Uttoxeter

Derby - Willington - Burton upon Trent

Arkwright's Cromford Mill, Cromford

The world's first successful water powered cotton spinning mill, now being restored to its former glory. **Free entry for one child with each full paying adult.**

Blue John Cavern, Castleton

Close to 'shivering mountain' Mam Tor, the Blue John Cavern offers fine show caves and stalagmite formation amongst the rich Blue John stone. **Free entry for one child with each full paying adult.**

Bolsover Castle,* Bolsover

Impressive 17th Century mansion on the site of a Norman Castle, high above the town of Bolsover. **20% off normal admission prices.**

Crich Tramway Village, Crich

Step back in time for a nostalgic family day out at Crich Tramway Village. Ride on vintage trams through the period street and explore fascinating exhibitions. **Up to £3.00 off normal rates.**

Eyam Museum, Eyam

Step back in time to the famous plague village and learn about those who sacrificed their lives to protect their neighbors.

Free entry for one person with each full paying adult.

Gulliver's Kingdom, Matlock Bath

Haddon Hall, near Bakewell

Stately home of the Manners family for 800 years.

Better known today as the setting for many TV programmes and films including Jane Eyre and Pride and Prejudice. The house and gardens are one of the oldest and best preserved in England.

Hardwick Old Hall,* near Glapwell

Next to Hardwick Hall this is the ruin of Bess of Hardwick's 16th Century mansion. Spectacular views.

Take the cable car for stunning views across the Derwent Valley. At the summit discover two magnificent show caverns, nature trails, play areas and maze set in a 60 acre park.

Large Tudor tax collector's house which exhibits toys, costumes and tools from a time gone by. See how a Victorian Mill worker's family lived. Operate the bellows in the blacksmiths shop.
