Safer Derbyshire

Safer Derbyshire is a multi-agency partnership based at County Hall, Matlock. We aim to reduce crime, disorder and the fear of crime in Derbyshire by providing support, advice and leadership to partners and communities. We provide a wide range of free community safety classroom courses and eLearning modules for Derbyshire County Council staff and partner agencies in Derbyshire.

Classroom courses: Community Safety Introduction, Domestic Abuse Awareness, Hate Crime Awareness, MARAC training, Modern Slavery Awareness, Substance Misuse and Community Safety, Workshop to Raise Awareness of Prevent (WRAP).

E-learning courses: Community Safety: An Introduction, Anti-Social Behaviour, Child Sexual Exploitation, Cybercrime and Online Safety, Domestic Abuse, Hate Crime, Modern Slavery, Prevent (Counter Terrorism).

How to access our training: To book a place on a classroom course or to access our eLearning modules, you will need a Derbyshire Learning Online account. Derbyshire County Council staff and Elected Members already have accounts within Derbyshire Learning Online.

- **If you have an account:** Log into <https://derbyshire.learningpool.com> with your username or email address and your password. If you cannot remember your password, use the 'lost password' function on the log-in page. Search for your course and click 'enroll me' to enroll onto it. For classroom courses, you will also need to click 'sign-up' to book your place online for your chosen date.
- **If you do not yet have an account:** Partner agencies can request access to our courses. Email communitysafety.training@derbyshire.gov.uk to request a 'registration key', tell us which courses you are interested in and which agency you work for in Derbyshire. You will then be sent information on how to create an account. Once your account has been approved you can book your course as described above.
